



Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE) Warrant

Who is affected:

ALL immigrants, regardless of race, gender, religion, and/or previous interactions with the justice system

ALL Illinois residents, institutions, and businesses that would continue to benefit from the contributions that immigrants make to Illinois' diversity, culture, and economic success

Who is not affected:

institutions of higher learning, schools and high schools from asking about the students' or the student's family's immigration status, with few

issued warrant

state funded elementary school, high school or institution of higher learning

state funded health care centers and

medical treatment or health facilities on immigration issues and how to respond to immigration officials

ICE is not authorized to enter a residence without a warrant or consent of the occupant.
